Installation

Drag the Doorman icon somewhere on your hard disk (usually to the Applications folder). Now you may eject the Disk Image and delete the doorman.dmg file. (Well not as long as you have this Manual open of course, but when you've finished reading)

License

Doorman is freeware.

All our Software-Licenses include a Green-License which means that if you want to use the Software you have to do something against Climate Change or pollution. It is up to you what you would like to do, but of course doing more good is better. We suggest doing things like

- replace a conventional light bulb with an energy efficient CFL-bulb
- go to work by bike (of course: bicycle not motor cycle)
- buy a new fridge
- or just put your computer to sleep when you leave for lunch

All these actions will reduce your Carbon Foot-Print and also save you money. For example replacing a conventional light bulb will save you about €16 per year (including acquisition costs). That will payoff the price of a €5 software product within 4 months. A new Fridge or not using your car will result in an even greater bargain. Nice, isn't it?

To use Doorman you must read and agree to the attached end user license agreement (EULA).

Build Password

Length, Numbers, Letters, Upper Case

To build a random password, you need to indicate the wished password length and can choose the characters used in your password. You can select numbers, special characters and letters (only lower case or mixed upper and lower case letters).

Speakable Password

If you want a memorable password that is still safe (what, as you know, words that appear in a dictionary are not) you can use Doorman's Speakable-Password-

Generator, that creates a password following the syllable-construction-scheme of natural language.

To increase your passwords safety you can append numbers and special characters to it - they will be inserted between two syllables, so the password remains speakable.

Password Safety

Because it is important that your password is safe, you can see the grade of safety in a scale and adjust the settings in the password-generator (e.g. the length) if necessary. When the scale is red your password can be cracked in under an hour, yellow passwords are save enough for web accounts where the attacker has to wait some seconds after every tried password. Green passwords are save enough for your private data on your harddisk (if your encryption software has no security holes of course).

System Requirements

Doorman runs on every Mac with Mac OS 10.4 (Tiger) or higher installed.
